
How to Miter a Corner

To miter a corner the quick and easy way: Sew border & stop 1/4" from the corners or whatever your seal allowance is, stop that distance from the corners. Leave a "tail" the width of the border plus a couple of inches. Lay quilt flat, right side up. On each corner, one at a time, fold one of the borders from the corner making the tails parallel. Press. Pin. Sew on creased line.



Right side of quilt, right side of border, border seam pressed toward border. Right side border (then left side), on both ends is folded from corner so tail is parallel with top and bottom borders, ironed to crease, then pinned and sewn on
