
## How to Join Binding Ends

**To join binding ends:** Sew binding to quilt edge, leaving an opening of 10 to 12" along one side and longer tails. In the middle, cut one end nice and straight & fold the other back even with the cut edge. However wide your binding is, cut the folded edge that far from the fold usually 2 to 2 1/2" from the fold, leaving the binding longer than the opening.

2 to 2 1/2" depending on how wide your binding is cut



Open out binding & right sides together sew a diagonal seam. Trim. Fold again & complete attaching to quilt. The binding will fit perfectly. Diagonal seams avoid the bulkiness of a straight seam that is folded over on itself. You cannot tell where the beginning or ending of the binding is and it looks professional.

Dotted line indicates fold line on binding—have to open it to sew final edges together.
